NRC Names Henry Strittmatter as Resident Inspector at the Comanche Peak Nuclear Power Plant



The Nuclear Regulatory Commission has selected Henry Strittmatter as the new resident inspector at the Comanche Peak nuclear power plant in Glen Rose, Texas.

"Henry's Naval experience, coupled with the hands-on training he received during inspector qualifications, will help ensure the continued safety of Comanche Peak," said NRC Region IV Administrator John Monninger.

Strittmatter joined the NRC in 2021 and has served as an emergency preparedness inspector since 2022 in the agency's Region IV office in Arlington, Texas. He is a 10-year veteran of the U.S. Navy and served on the USS George Washington aircraft carrier as a nuclear reactor division officer. He holds a bachelor's degree in civil engineering from the University of New Mexico.

Each U.S. commercial nuclear power plant site has at least two NRC resident inspectors. Strittmatter joins senior resident inspector John Ellegood at Comanche Peak. They serve as the agency's eyes and ears at the facility, conducting inspections, monitoring significant work projects, and interacting with plant workers and the public.
