NRC NAMES NEW SENIOR RESIDENT INSPECTOR
AT OCONEE NUCLEAR POWER PLANT

Nuclear Regulatory Commission officials in Atlanta have announced the assignment of Mike Scott as the agency's Senior Resident Inspector at the Oconee nuclear power plant, located near Seneca, South Carolina. He succeeds Paul Harmon, the Senior Resident Inspector at the Oconee plant since 1991.

Scott began his career as a research assistant at the Walter Reed Army Institute of Research and then at the University of Baylor College of Medicine in Houston, Texas. Prior to joining the NRC in 1984, Scott was a lead engineer at the Puget Sound Naval Shipyard in Bremerton, Washington. At the NRC, Scott has worked as a reactor inspector, project engineer and a resident inspector at the St. Lucie and Farley nuclear plants. He received a degree in Biochemistry from the University of West Florida and a degree in Mechanical Engineering from the University of Houston.

Scott officially became the Senior Resident Inspector at the Oconee plant on August 4, joining NRC Resident Inspectors Gary Humphrey and Nancy Salgado. The NRC inspectors at the Oconee plant can be reached at 864-882-6927.
