NRC ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON REACTOR SAFEGUARDS TO MEET IN ROCKVILLE, MARYLAND ON APRIL 28

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards has scheduled a joint meeting of its subcommittees on plant operations and on reliability and probabilistic risk assessment on April 28 in Rockville, Maryland.
