NRC STAFF TO MEET WITH NORTHEAST UTILITIES, PUBLIC ON MILLSTONE

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff will meet with officials of Northeast Utilities on Tuesday, August 12, for the latest in a series of periodic meetings to discuss plans, schedules and progress toward restart of the Millstone Units in Waterford, Ct.
