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NRC ANNOUNCES WORKSHOP ON MEDICAL RULE DRAFT INSPECTION GUIDANCE

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission will conduct a workshop on June 6 to discuss and obtain comments on draft inspection guidance for medical use licensees.

The workshop will be held from 9 a.m. until 5 p.m. at NRC headquarters in the Auditorium, located at Two White Flint North, 11545 Rockville Pike, Rockville, Maryland. It will focus on the revised guidance to facilitate inspections under the recently published revision to NRC's regulations on medical use of byproduct material. NRC is especially interested in comments that will improve the guidance to be more oriented toward end results and make more use of risk information. The workshop will be preceded by an open house at 8 a.m., which will provide an opportunity for informal interactions between NRC staff and meeting attendees.
