Environmental scoping meetings were conducted to support the review of the Quad Cities Nuclear Power Station, Units 1 and 2 (QCNPS) license renewal application submitted by Exelon Generation Company, LLC (Exelon). The public meetings were conducted in the afternoon and evening on Tuesday, April 8, 2003, at The Mark of the Quad Cities Convention Center, in Moline, Illinois. Approximately 120 people attended the meetings, including members of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff and the environmental review team leader, members of the public, representatives from Exelon, and State and local government officials. There were a total of 15 members of the public and local government officials who provided comments (11 at the afternoon meeting and 4 at the evening meeting). Comments were in support of, and opposition to, license renewal; such as the ongoing issue between Exelon and local government officials regarding a proposal by Exelon to lower the appraised value of the QCNPS as a step toward reducing tax payments; other impacts of QCNPS on the local economy; emergency preparedness; spent fuel transportation and storage; consideration of alternative fuels; and the operation of an on-site fish hatchery. Enclosures 1 and 2 contain the official corrected transcripts for the afternoon and evening sessions. Enclosure 3 is a copy of the slides used in the NRC's presentation.
