
Browns Ferry Nuclear Plant, Units 1, 2, and 3 License Renewal

- Current operating licenses expire
 - ► Unit 1 20 Dec 2013
 - ► Unit 2 28 Jun 2014
 - ► Unit 3 − 2 Jul 2016
- Application requests authorization to operate units for an additional 20 years



NRC's License Renewal Review

- Safety review
- > Environmental review
- Plant inspections
- Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards (ACRS)





National Environmental Policy Act

- NEPA requires Federal agencies to use a systematic approach to consider environmental impacts
- An Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) is required for major Federal actions significantly affecting the quality of the human environment
- Commission has determined that a supplement to the "Generic EIS for License Renewal of Nuclear Plants" will be prepared for a license renewal application.



Decision Standard for Environmental Review


To determine whether or not the adverse environmental impacts of license renewal for Browns Ferry Nuclear Plant, Units 1, 2, and 3, are so great that preserving the option of license renewal for energy planning decisionmakers would be unreasonable.

Notice of Intent March 10, 2004



Requests for Additional Information (RAI) By May 24, 2004



Draft SEIS December 2004 Final SEIS by July 2005


