(DNC). The public meetings were conducted in the afternoon and evening on Tuesday, May 18, 2004, at the Waterford Town Hall, in Waterford, Connecticut. Approximately 100 people attended the meetings, including members of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff and the environmental review team, members of the public, representatives from DNC, and State and local government officials.
