SUMMARY OF THE IN-OFFICE REVIEW RELATED TO THE CLASSIFIED MATTER
PROTECTION PLAN FOR THE MIXED OXIDE FUEL FABRICATION FACILITY

PURPOSE

This purpose of the in-office review was to discuss, in detail, MOX Services draft responses to the staff's second request for additional information related to the Classified Matter Protection Plan (CMPP) for the Mixed Oxide Fuel Fabrication Facility.

DISCUSSION

The following is a summary of the topics that were discussed during the in-office review.

The applicant provided an overview of their responses to the NRC's second request for additional information related to the CMPP. Changes to the plan include: clarification of titles and roles of individuals in the security organization; deletion of references to "U" clearances, limitations on personnel access to security storage containers, combination lock changes, security education, conformance to the latest version of NRC's security information standard format, and handling and carrying of classified information at the facility.

Outstanding items that will need to be resolved between the NRC and the Department of Energy (DOE) prior to inclusion in the CMPP are: a) granting and verification of clearances by NRC/DOE, and b) the designation of the Cognizant Security Agency between NRC and DOE.

The next step for the applicant is to submit formal responses to the second round of RAIs.
