## 1.0 INTRODUCTION

The Kewaunee Power Station is a 598 megawatt pressurized water reactor located on the Wisconsin shore of Lake Michigan in Kewaunee County. The Plant became critical on March 7, 1974. Initial power generation was achieved on April 8, 1974, and the Plant was declared commercial on June 16, 1974. This report summarizes the environmental operation data collected during the period January - December 2008.
