Dear Mr. Kay:

We have completed our initial technical reviews regarding the safety and security areas of your license application for a gas centrifuge enrichment facility, the Eagle Rock Enrichment Facility, which is proposed to be constructed and operated in Bonneville County, Idaho. Your application was transmitted by letter dated December 30, 2008, and revised on April 23, 2009. Our review of your application has identified that additional information is needed before the staff can take final action on your license application.

The enclosed Request for Additional Information (RAI) addresses the license application only, including the exemption request in Section 1.2.5 of the safety analysis report related to incremental financial assurance. The enclosed RAI does not address the environmental report (ER). Questions and comments on our review of the ER have been provided separately, by letter dated August 10, 2009.

You will note that Enclosure 2 is non-public as it contains questions related to the integrated safety analysis (ISA) summary, emergency plan, physical security plan, and classified information plan. These questions are Official Use Only because they contain sensitive unclassified security-related information. As you are aware, the NRC Regulatory Issue Summary 2005-31 provides guidance for the submission of security-related sensitive unclassified non-safeguards information by applicants.

Please provide the additional information requested in the attachments within 30 days of the date of this letter.
