NRC POSTPONES MEETINGS IN PIKETON SCHEDULED TO DISCUSS PORTSMOUTH GASEOUS DIFFUSION PLANT AND LEAD CASCADE FACILITY

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff has postponed two public meetings scheduled for Sept. 23 in Piketon, Ohio, to discuss results of the agency's most recent reviews of the United States Enrichment Corporation's Portsmouth Gaseous Diffusion Plant and the USEC Inc.'s American Centrifuge Lead Cascade Facility located at the same site.

The meetings are being postponed because the Department of Energy's Site Specific Advisory Board for the Piketon plant is meeting the same evening and some officials and members of the public contacted the NRC to ask whether the NRC meetings could be postponed.

The NRC will reschedule the meetings soon and issue a meeting announcement and news release once the new date is confirmed.
