PURPOSE: The NRC staff will discuss with affected stakeholders comments relevant to the staff's draft regulatory basis (previously referred to as the draft technical basis) for the forthcoming security rulemaking to revise 10 CFR Parts 72, "Licensing Requirements for the Independent Storage of Spent Nuclear Fuel, High-Level Radioactive Waste, and Reactor-Related Greater Than Class C Waste," and 73, "Physical Protection of Plants and Materials," that would apply during the storage of spent nuclear fuel (SNF) at an Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation (ISFSI) and the storage of SNF and high-level radioactive waste (HLW) at a Monitored Retrievable Storage Installation (MRS) A meeting agenda is attached to this notice.

CATEGORY: This is a Category 2 meeting.¹ The public is invited to participate in the public portion of this meeting by discussing regulatory issues with the agency at designated points during the public portion of the meeting identified on the agenda (Enclosure 1).
