NRC SCHEDULES MEETING OCT. 20 TO DISCUSS AREVA EAGLE ROCK ENRICHMENT FACILITY

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff has scheduled a public meeting to discuss the status of the AREVA Eagle Rock Enrichment Facility, which has just received a license and will be constructed in Idaho Falls, Idaho.

The meeting is scheduled for Thursday, Oct. 20, at 1 p.m. EDT at the NRC's Region II offices, located at 245 Peachtree Center Ave., NE, in Atlanta. The meeting will be open to observation by the public and NRC staff will be available to answer questions after the business portion of the meeting.

The meeting will include presentations by the licensee, AREVA Enrichment Services LLC, on the status of the project and the facility's quality assurance plan. The NRC staff will also discuss the agency's construction inspection program and inspection plans for the facility.
