NRC TO MEET WITH WOLF CREEK NUCLEAR POWER PLANT OFFICIALS

U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff will meet with officials from the Wolf Creek Nuclear Operating Corp. on Nov. 9 to discuss initiatives being implemented to improve performance of the Wolf Creek nuclear plant near Burlington, Kansas.

The meeting, which is open to public observation, will begin at 8 a.m. in the NRC Region IV office at 612 E. Lamar Blvd., in Arlington, Texas.

Conferees will discuss the status of actions being taken to strengthen performance in the areas of problem identification and resolution and human performance.
