# Main Enhancements for Licensees

- Alerts
  - Overdue transfers
  - Pending transfers
  - Source decayed
  - Overdue AIR
- View transfer progress
- Review transfer history

# Main Enhancements for Regulators

- Alerts
  - Lost/stolen sources
  - Secondary recipient on most licensee alerts
- Queries
- Review source history
- Reports



## Security Categorization

- Process of determining the appropriate sensitivity of the source information in NSTS
- SECY -11-0094 Advantages and Disadvantages of Changing the Current Authentication Assurance Level (Level 4) of the National Source Tracking System
- Commission approved reducing the authentication assurance level of NSTS from Level 4 to Level 3


## Annual Inventory Reconciliation

- •Inventories will be generated the last two weeks in December
- Inventory reports to be mailed to primary contact in NSTS by certified mail to the facility street address
- Packages will include inventory, instructions, confirmation sheet, and correction sheet
- Reconciliation is as of the date on the inventory report
- •Ensure the information is legible on the forms so it can be processed



#### Forward Focus

- Maintenance Release 2.1
- Marketing effort
- Switch to Level 3
- Transactions related to temporary job sites
- Data cleanup

- Report within one business day
- Use the right form
- Complete all required information
- Source not device information
- Go online
- Inventory reconciliation is coming
