On March 12, 2012, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) issued Reference (a) to all power reactor licensees. The NRC letter requests further information from addressees to support the evaluation of NRC Staff Recommendation 2.3: Seismic from the Near-Term Task Force review of the accident at the Fukushima Dai-ichi nuclear facility. Reference (a) further requested a response within 180 days of NRC's endorsement of the seismic walkdown procedure.

Reference (b), confirmed that Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant, Unit 2 will use the seismic walkdown procedure, Electric Power Research Institute (EPRI) 1025286, *Seismic Walkdown Guidance: For Resolution of Fukushima Near-Term Task Force Recommendation 2.3: Seismic*. The walkdown procedure was endorsed in Reference (c).
