On March 12, 2012, the NRC issued Reference 1 to all power reactor licensees and holders of construction permits in active or deferred status. Enclosure 3 of Reference 1 contains specific Requested Actions, Requested Information, and Required Responses associated with Recommendation 2.3 for Seismic. This letter provides the 180-day response to Reference 1 for Recommendation 2.3 for Seismic for I&M, the licensee for Donald C. Cook Nuclear Plant (CNP) Units 1 and 2.

Seismic walkdowns and area walkbys were performed and a final report was prepared using NRC-endorsed guidance prepared by the Electric Power Research Institute (EPRI) per References 2 and 3. The final report is provided as Enclosure 2. Components that could not be examined due to reasons of industrial or radiological safety will be evaluated during the upcoming Unit 1 and Unit 2 refueling outages in 2013. A listing of these components can be found in Appendix E of the final report. Regulatory commitments to perform the remaining walkdowns and to update the seismic walkdown report are provided as Enclosure 3.
