Dear Sir or Madam:

On March 12, 2012, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission ("NRC" or "Commission") issued an order [Reference 1] to James A. FitzPatrick Nuclear Power Plant (JAF). Reference 1 was immediately effective and directs JAF to develop, implement, and maintain guidance and strategies to maintain or restore core cooling, containment, and spent fuel pool cooling

capabilities in the event of a beyond-design-basis external event. Specific requirements are outlined in Attachment 2 of Reference 1.

Reference 1 required submission of an initial status report 60 days following issuance of the final interim staff guidance [Reference 2] and an overall integrated plan pursuant to Section IV, Condition C.2. Reference 2 endorses industry guidance document NEI 12-06, Revision 0 [Reference 3] with clarifications and exceptions identified in Reference 2. Reference 4 provided the JAF initial status report regarding mitigation strategies. Reference 5 provided the JAF overall integrated plan.

Reference 1 requires submission of a status report at six-month intervals following submittal of the overall integrated plan. Reference 3 provides direction regarding the content of the status reports. The purpose of this letter is to provide the first six-month status report pursuant to Section IV, Condition C.2, of Reference 1, that delineates progress made in implementing the requirements of Reference 1. The attached report provides an update of milestone accomplishments since the last status report, including any changes to the compliance method, schedule, or need for relief and the basis, if any.

4. Changes to Compliance Method

There are no changes to the compliance method as documented in the Overall Integrated Plan [Reference 1].

The JAF integrated plan indicated compliance with the subject order would include implementation of NRC Order EA-12-050, "Issuance of Order to Modify License with Regard to Reliable Containment Hardened Vents". Subsequent to the submittal of the integrated plan, the NRC rescinded Order EA-12-050 and issued Order EA-13-109 "Issue of Order to Modify Licenses With Regard to Reliable Containment Vents Capable of Operation Under Severe Accident Conditions." JAF will implement requirements of Phase 1 of Order EA-13-109 instead of Order EA-12-050. Phase 1 of Order EA-13-109 currently requires implementation in 2016 at JAF and thus no change in schedule for compliance is currently contemplated.
