SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF THE OCTOBER 1, 2013, PUBLIC MEETING TO

DISCUSS CUMULATIVE EFFECTS OF REGULATION ON FUEL

CYCLE FACILITIES

The staff of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission met with the fuel cycle industry and Nuclear Energy Institute (NEI) representatives in a Category 2 public meeting on October 1, 2013. The purpose of this meeting was to: highlight the current agency actions on Cumulative Effects of Regulation (CER); present and discuss a proposed integrated schedule listing activities that contribute to CER for fuel cycle facilities; obtain feedback from the fuel cycle industry on the structure and use of the proposed schedule; and discuss a path forward for continuing to enhance effective communication on CER. The partially populated schedule addressed several of the contributors to CER discussed during the June 10, 2013, public meeting with the fuel cycle industry (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System Accession Number ML13170A199). Action Items from the October 1, 2013, meeting are identified in the Enclosure 1 Meeting Summary. No regulatory decisions or commitments were made during the meeting.
