1. What are the known technical or regulatory issues with the current version of the Regulatory Guide (RG)?

RG 8.35 (Rev. 1), published in August 2010, provides guidance on the conditions and prerequisites for permitting planned special exposure(s) that are consistent with the current requirements in Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) Part 20, "Standards for Protection Against Radiation."
