Errata

NUREG/KM-0010, "WASH-1400 – The Reactor Safety Study – The Introduction of Risk Assessment to the Regulation of Nuclear Reactors," published August 2016.

Page 17, the fifth sentence of, "Another Attempt at a Probabilistic Approach," should have the value of 10^{-6} instead of the correct value of 10^{-16} . The full sentence should read, "If the 10^{-16} estimate were true, that would mean a reactor might operate 700,000 times longer than the currently assumed age of the universe before experiencing a major accident."

Page 37, the last sentence states, "The follow (sic) page identifies key events related to the TMI accident." The correct wording is, "The figure on Page 34 identifies key events related to the TMI accident."

Page 41 photo label should say, "Japanese chemical/oil plant fire after the Great Tohoku earthquake (the same earthquake that caused the tsunami impacting the Fukushima Nuclear Plant)."
