RG 8.9, Revision 1, was issued in 1993 to provide methods acceptable to the NRC staff for estimating intake of radionuclides using bioassay measurements pursuant to 10 CFR 20.1502, "Conditions requiring individual monitoring of external and internal occupational dose," 10 CFR 20.1204(c)(1), "Determination of internal exposure," and 10 CFR 20.1703(a)(3)(ii), "Use of individual respiratory protection equipment."

No technical or regulatory issues were identified as a result of this review. The guide is consistent with the current regulations and their corresponding citations.
