In accordance with Title 10 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 50.82(a)(1)(i), Entergy hereby certifies to the NRC that power operations ceased at Pilgrim Nuclear Power Station (PNPS) on May 31, 2019. Per 10 CFR 50.82(a)(1)(ii), Entergy also certifies that the fuel was permanently removed from the PNPS reactor vessel and placed in the spent fuel pool on June 9, 2019. Entergy understands and acknowledges that upon docketing these certifications, the PNPS 10 CFR Part 50 license no longer authorizes operation of the reactor or emplacement or retention of fuel into the reactor vessel.
