The Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation, Region I, and our Records Resource office were tasked to conduct searches for responsive records. As a general rule, staff has told us that the NRC does not maintain copies of contracts that a licensee has with the company that is building the plant. Accordingly, we would expect records relating to this construction to be in the possession of the licensee. One document was located; it is already publicly available in ADAMS as ML011720635.
