conduct a search; NMSS staff has provided the following information:	:

NRC's response to a similar FOIA request is made publicly available in ADAMS at ML20042D360. The latest Defueled Safety Analysis Report (DSAR), dated November 2020, is available at ML20343A228; however, some of the information in this version was relocated to a controlled document; our Region IV office has confirmed that NRC has neither access to, nor a copy of, it.

NMSS staff has also told us that the preoperational inspection report for the Holtec ISFSI system is available at ML18200A400. It mentions that the inspectors reviewed Southern California Edison's site-specific evaluations to determine that the site conformed to limitations in the Holtec SAR for environmental phenomena (flood, wind, tornado, etc.).
