Notice of Intent to Pursue Subsequent License Renewal for Prairie Island Nuclear Generating Plant

In the referenced letter, the NRC described the importance of providing advance notice of the intent to pursue license renewal.

This letter provides notification that Northern States Power Company, a Minnesota corporation, doing business as Xcel Energy, hereafter NSPM, is planning to submit an application for the second renewed license for the Prairie Island Nuclear Generating Plant, in the fourth quarter of 2026. The Certificate of Need for expansion of the Prairie Island Nuclear Generating Plant Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation (ISFSI) will be filed with the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission in February 2024 pursuant to Minnesota Statute §216B.243.
